**Annual statistical summary of reported losses and disposals of propelled
sea-going merchant ships of not less than 100 GT.**

PREFACE

The WORLD CASUALTY STATISTICS is a new annual publication from Lloyd's Register, and has been designed to replace the Casualty Return.

A major characteristic of this annual statistical assessment of reported total losses and disposals of propelled sea-going merchant ships is that it is more shiptype oriented - particularly cargo carrying shiptypes. A further characteristic is that certain time series tables will be continually updated from one issue to the next - this reflects the continuous acquisition of data beyond the publication date of the current issue.

The shiptype categories used are based upon 'A Categorisation of Ships by Type' shown opposite.

In addition to non-propelled ships and, more generally, ships of less than 100 gross tonnage, pleasure craft, naval auxiliaries, and ships restricted to harbour service or river / canal service, are not included in this publication.

The definitions of the shiptypes comprising the shiptype categories (basic groupings) are based upon primary design function - with hull structure and, for cargo carrying ships the cargo handling mode, or modes, being given due prominence. Hence, the numbers of ships pertaining to the shiptype categories of this new publication may differ from those of the categories used in previous publications.

Each of the tables of data gives the number of ships (No.) and aggregate gross tonnage (GT), or aggregate deadweight (Dwt) for cargo carrying shiptypes. Average age (Age) is also included in many of the tables.

For the purpose of this publication, total losses refer to propelled sea-going merchant ships of not less than 100 GT which, as a result of being a marine casualty, have ceased to exist, either by virtue of the fact that the ships are irrecoverable or have subsequently been broken up. Ships which have been declared constructive total losses but which are undergoing or have undergone repairs are not included. Ships broken up, but not as a consequence of casualty, are categorised as disposals.

A new feature of this publication is the separation of losses into actual total losses and constructive total losses - the former being mostly foundered incidents, the latter more dependant upon the cost of repair and the value of the ship. Constructive total losses are primarily ships broken up as a result of a casualty incident.

The contents of this publication pertain to the year of the casualty incident for both actual and constructive total losses, and to the year scrapping commenced for disposals.

The casualty incident categories used in this publication are:-

| (i) | Foundered | Includes ships which sank as a result of heavy weather, springing of leaks, breaking in two, etc., but not as a consequence of categories listed below. |
| (ii) | Missing | After a reasonable period of time, no news having been received of a ship and its fate being therefore undetermined, the ship is posted as 'missing' at the Corporation of Lloyd's or reported as such from another reliable source. |
| (iii) | Fire/explosion | Includes ships lost as a result of fire and/or explosion where it is the first event reported - it therefore follows that casualties including fires and/or explosions after collisions, strandings, etc. would be categorised under 'collision', 'wrecked/stranded'. |
| (iv) | Collision | Includes ships lost as a result of striking or being struck by another ship, regardless of whether under way, anchored or moored. |
| (v) | Contact | Includes ships lost as a result of striking an external substance - but not another ship (collision) or the sea bottom (wrecked/stranded). This category includes striking drilling rigs/platforms, regardless of whether in fixed position or in tow. |
| (vi) | Wrecked/stranded | Includes ships lost as a result of touching the sea bottom, sandbanks or seashore, etc., as well as entanglement on underwater wrecks. |
| (vii) | Other | Includes war loss (and encompassing loss occasioned to ships by hostile acts), hull/machinery damage or failure which is not attributable to any other category, and losses which, for want of sufficient reasons, cannot be classified. |

Appendix 1 lists, for individual ships, this year's total losses - sorted by shiptype category and casualty incident type (to enable cross reference with the appropriate tables of this publication).

Similarly, Appendix 2 lists the disposals - sorted by shiptype category and country of breaking.

STATISTICAL NOTES

Overall summary

During the year 184 ships of 1.6 million gross tonnage were reported as total losses. Reported disposals totalled 641 ships of 10.4 million gross tonnage.

The number of total losses of cargo carrying ships was 116 ships of 1.5 million GT (2.6 million Dwt), and for disposals, the number was 401 ships of 9.9 million GT (19.1 million Dwt).

The following is an overall summary, for all shiptype categories, of reported losses (actual total losses and constructive total losses) and disposals for the current and previous five years.

The number of persons reported killed or missing (lives lost) as a result of total losses during the year was 1 552.

The year's most notable total losses in terms of lives lost were the ESTONIA (passenger/ro-ro cargo) which capsized and sank with the loss of 852 lives, and the CEBU CITY (passenger/general cargo) which sank after collision with the loss of 145 lives.

The following summarises lives lost (as a result of total losses) for the current and previous five years for certain principal shiptype categories.

Total losses

Disposals

Having previously analysed disposals by shiptype category, this final section considers disposals by registration and by country of breaking.

Table 8 gives the year's reported disposals, by registration, for the two shiptype component groupings of cargo carrying ships and ships of miscellaneous activities.

Table 9 continues the analysis of disposals by considering registration and shiptype category. Individual registration authority totals are given in Table 8.

Table 10 shows disposals by registration (principal authorities only) for the current and previous five years.

Table 11 gives the year's reported disposals, by country of breaking, for the two shiptype component groupings of cargo carrying ships and ships of miscellaneous activities.
